Check-IT in China

Vijf hogescholen hebben in samenwerking met de Universiteit van Xiamen het China Holland Exchange Competence and Knowledge centre for Information Technology gerealiseerd. In februari 2013 is de 8ste groep van 15-25 Nederlandse studenten een stagesemester begonnen in Xiamen, China. Zij werken samen met 15-25 Chinese studenten in een ICT-projectcentrum aan projecten voor bedrijven in het Software Park van Xiamen waar 500 ICT-bedrijven zijn gehuisvest. De studenten ontwikkelen hun individuele hbo-competenties in een unieke context. Internationaal, intercultureel en ondernemend in relatie tot de ICT-bedrijven in de omgeving van het Check-IT-centrum.

De presentatie lichtte de ontwikkeling, ervaringen en stand van zaken rondom Check-IT toe. Ook de deelname van studenten van andere hogescholen in een internationale stage of minor kwam aan bod.

Introduction of CHECK-IT

CHECK-IT is a consortium consisting of Software School of Xiamen University and partner Universities (2007-2013), Leiden University of Applied Science, The Hague University of Applied Science, Zuyd University of Applied Science, HAN University of Applied Science, Leiden University, and Laurea University of Applied Science. Two institutions of the partner universities (ICLON and the Institute of Education, Xiamen University) offer educational and cross-cultural advisers.

Short History

In November, 2007, the delegation of Institutes of Higher Education in the Netherlands visited the software park during the meeting with Xiamen University and had the idea of collaborative construction of training base (figure 1).

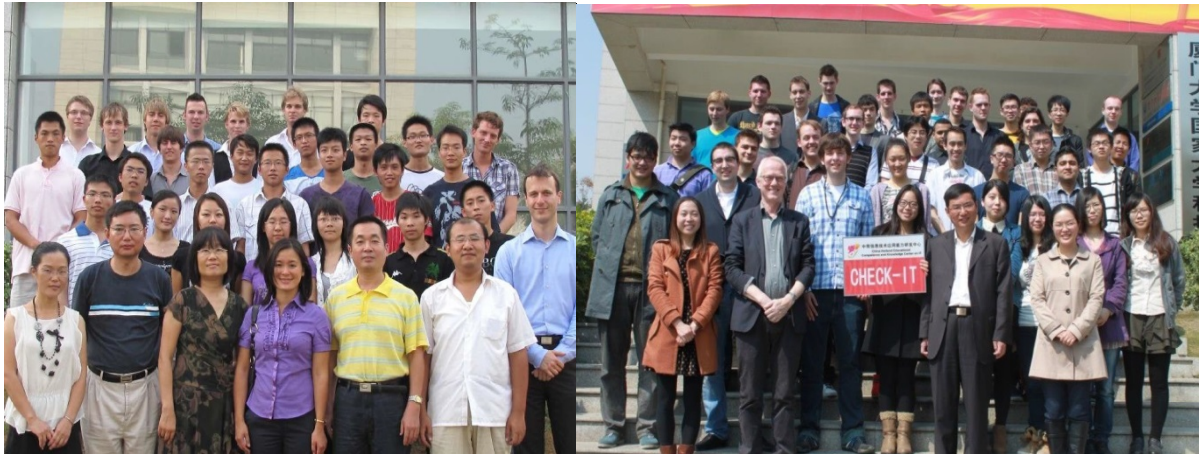


Figure 2. First (2009) and eight (2013) group of staff and students in CHECK-IT-project.

On August 28th, 2009, the opening ceremony of the first CHECK-IT group Center was held in Xiamen University Software School and on January 18th, 2010, the graduation ceremony of the first CHECK-IT group was held in the Software Park. On Feb. 25th, 2013, the opening ceremony of the **eighth** CHECK-IT group was held in the Software Park (figure 2).

Location, facilities, staff and students of CHECK-IT

CHECK-IT center composed of one student lab, one meeting room with a coffee bar and two lecture offices, occupies approx. 950 M2 area. The center is equipped with advanced computers and IBM, DELL Servers. Devices as fax machines, scanners, projectors, laser printers, network printers and the fiber network. The participating staff working in the project since the start in 2009 is total 18 Chinese staff, 22 Dutch and 1 Finnish staff. Of total 290 students participating in CHECK-IT were 157 Chinese 125 Dutch and 8 Finnish students.

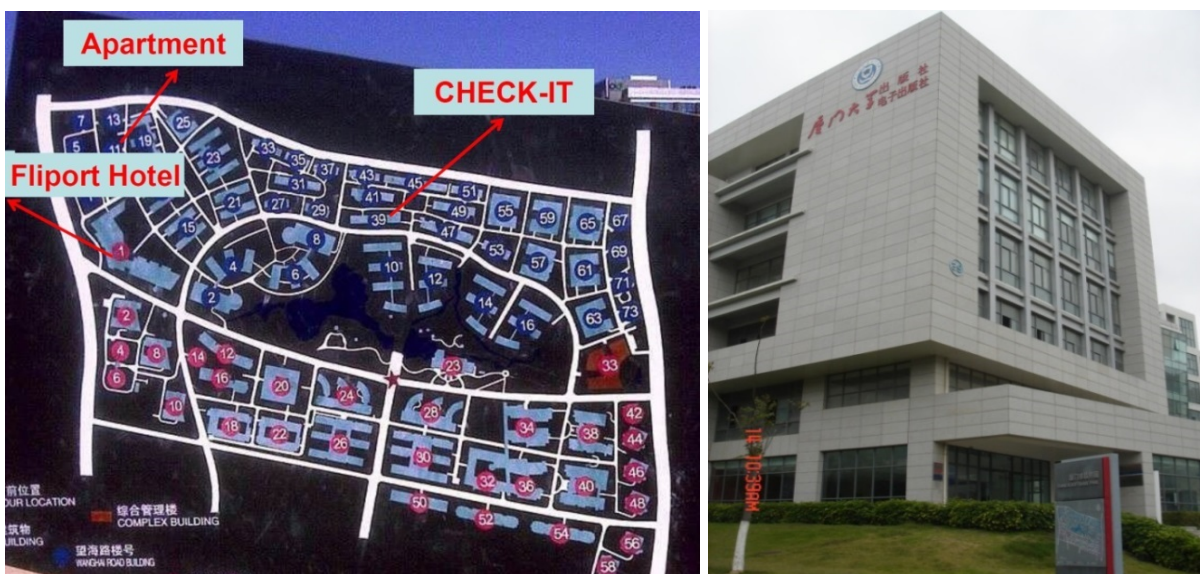


Figure 3. Software Park and Building where CHECK-IT Project is located.
